

PFS Protocol: Law Enforcement Data

Purpose

This tool will be used to gather information about law enforcement incidents on your campus and in the surrounding community. These incidents do not have to involve students to have an impact on the campus community, including protecting students, building awareness, enforcing consequences, and influencing perceptions of enforcement.

How to gather this information

- Partner with Wilder Research to update the form below for your campus community, including adding your staff names and contact information, and your local law enforcement agencies.
- Contact your local law enforcement office(s) and explain your grant role, current assessment activities underway, and your interest in partnering with them to track the number of substance use citations being issued. Depending on your service area, you may need to contact more than one law enforcement office, including your campus law enforcement, city police department(s), and/or county sheriff's office(s).
- Identify the individual within each law enforcement office who will be responsible for collecting this information. Provide them with the data collection form and your contact information so they know how to reach you with questions. Forms should be completed once per quarter by each agency, and returned to you within 10 days following the end of the previous quarter.
